To Covenanters across America who have a vision  
to reach the Russian-speaking people for Christ:

New Life Radio went on the air in 1996 to initiate a new era of Christian FM broadcasting for a people who had never known the freedom of religious radio in their own country (Russia).

In 2000, the Covenant denomination, along with HCJB Radio, set in motion the NEW LIFE RADIO Satellite Network from studios in Moscow, in order to provide Christian radio signals to every community across the former Soviet Union. The radio network has become an effective media resource for the Church in Russian-speaking nations, targeting Slavic young people worldwide via satellite, Internet radio, and FM!

Christian Radio for Russia, took over operations from the ECC in 2001 and continued its partnership with HCJB through 2009,

On April 15, HCJB was forced, due to declines in its donor base, to end its support for NLR's Hotbird satellite radio channel, that has a potential audience of 120 million households in its signal area. New Life Radio is without funds to continue on Hotbird beginning May 1, 2009.

To preserve this vast ministry outreach potential on Hotbird, Christian Radio for Russia has set up a *CRFR Fund for Russia* designed to provide yearly funding for NLR's satellite channel leases on the Hotbird and the ABS satellites.

**50 new Covenant church congregations or individuals pledging \$100 every month can ensure that Gospel radio via satellite will be available to the Russian-speaking people. We continue to need support for the remaining \$110,000 for the total budget of operating NLR.**
